A non-refundable registration fee of \$500 is required upon registration into the school. An early registration discount of \$100 will be applied to new and returning students registering during the designated early registration period.



### Financial Aid Information

Monsignor Edward Pace High School makes financial assistance available to all students who qualify regardless of race, color, creed, or national origin. All grants are in the form of financial aid.

Requirements for Participation:

1. The students must be registered for the next school year.
2. Complete application through TADS with ALL supporting documents (additional information may be requested by Pace High School or TADS).
3. Attainment and retention of a grade point average of at least 2.0. This must be maintained throughout the year. (Each grading period).
4. A satisfactory disciplinary record at the school for the previous year. This must be maintained throughout the year. (Disciplinary probation eliminates the award).
5. Satisfactory attendance and punctuality record.
