Some of the important topics you need to know to survive your child's first year of high school is carefully described in this survival guide! Before embarking on your journey with your child, please read the information below!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. ***How do I access Edline?*** Go to www.edline.net. Each child and parent is assigned their own username and password to login. Students receive it the first week of school. Parents receive it at Parent Orientation.
2. ***How do I stay informed?*** Monthly newsletters are sent home by mail detailing upcoming events. The monthly calendar is posted on Edline. Also on Edline, the class counselors and class moderators post important information and upcoming events.
3. ***How do I contact the teachers?*** You may contact the teachers using (a) the direct e-mail link through Edline or simply e-mail them directly. All e-mails are set up using the teacher's initial of the first name, the full last name @ pacehs.com. For example, John Smith would be jsmith@pacehs.com or (b) they can also be contacted by leaving a message for them in the main office. The quickest way to reach them is via e-mail.
4. ***How do I find out about athletic events?*** Go to www.viewmyschedule.com, search for Pace High School and find an updated calendar of games and practices. Information is available in a combined calendar or by sport.
5. ***How do I get involved in school?*** To get involved in our many events, substitute or to help in the clinic, contact the advancement office at ext. 212. Please note that all volunteers will need to undergo a complete background check.
6. ***What do I do to report an illness or to take my child out of school early?*** Call ext. 211 to report an illness. To take your child out of school early, you must come to the dean's office and sign them out.
7. ***How do I get in touch with my child in case of an emergency?*** Call ext. 211 in case of an emergency.
8. ***Does my child have to purchase a yearbook each year?*** No. The student activities fee includes your child's yearbook. Your child will receive one at the end of the school year.
9. ***What is the retreat requirement?*** Students are required to attend 2 retreats in order to graduate if they start at Pace as freshmen. Students who transfer in are required 1 retreat.
10. ***What is the community service hour requirement?*** All students are required to complete 75 hours of community service by March of their Junior (11th grade) year.
11. ***Should my child get involved in extracurricular activities?*** Yes. Most colleges and universities are looking for students who demonstrate initiative and maturity. This is displayed through the child's willingness to give back to the community through involvement and participation. This also fosters a sense of belonging which is very important for teenagers today. Each club has an Edline page that can be accessed via the Activities link found on the Edline home page.
